SKILLS TO SUCCESS



Skills to Success is a FREE youth skills and employment program designed to help youth gain employment in BC. The program includes 6 weeks of PAID in-class training and 10 weeks of work experience, leading to employment.

Benefits of the program

- You are PAID to attend workshops
- Other financial supports are available for the duration of the program
- Regular ongoing supports to address employment barriers
- Opportunity to develop a broad range of skills and knowledge, in order to gain and retain employment
- Education and skills development are promoted as being keys to successful employment

To join the Program you are:

- Between 15 to 30 years of age
- Legally entitled to work in Canada
- Eligible for Employment Insurance (EI)
- * A Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee status has been conferred
- Requiring assistance, to overcome employment barriers

Who can be in the Program

- LGBTQ2+, Indigenous group (self identified)
- Face multiple barriers to employment
- Homeless or at risk of becoming homeless
- * Living in a low income cut-off household
- * Living with a primary care responsibility
- * Affected by substance use
- Have had involvement in the justice system,
- Living with a disability
- Involuntary NEET (not in education, employment, training) for at least 4 months
- Recent immigrant of not more than 5 years
- * A member of visible or ethnic minority
- Out of school and unemployed
