- Experiencing homelessness
- Living in rural or remote areas.
- LGBTQ2

Basic Eligibility:

- Youth aged 15–30.
- Permanent residents or Canadian citizens
- Not enrolled in high school or post-secondary studies
- Unemployed or working less than 20 hours per week.
- Willing and available to work.
- EI, IA and CRB recipients
