Basic Eligibility:

- Youth aged 15 – 30.
- Permanent Resident, Canadian Citizen or Refugee Protected Person legally entitled to work in Canada.
- Not enrolled in full-time studies (secondary or post-secondary)
- Unemployed or Underemployed (less than 20 hrs)
- EI, IA and CRB recipients
- Committed and willing to get employed after training.
