Benefits from the program:

Start Date:

- 6 weeks paid class training
- 13 weeks on-the-job work experience
- Short-Term Certifications (First Aid, Customer Service, WHMIS, Food Safety)
- Funding for short-term courses/training
- Employment Support
- Working clothes and gear
- Child-care subsidy

Basic Eligibility:

- Youth aged 15 30.
- Permanent Resident, Canadian Citizen or Refugee Protected Person legally entitled to work in Canada.
- Not enrolled in high school or postsecondary
- Unemployed or Underemployed (less than 20 hrs)
- EI, IA or CRB recipients are eligible.
- Committed and willing to get employed after training.
